A local restaurateur and previous client contacted Acuform for the finish-out of a new restaurant location at the prestigious Alamo Quarry Market. As a second generation restaurant space, our planning took into account many of the systems already in place in order to reduce construction costs. Our design for the 3,500 sq. ft. space incorporates key elements which have become hallmarks of local chain while taking advantage of abundant natural light and introducing new features reminiscent of the Greek Isles.

We were able to develop an efficient kitchen layout which afforded the owner additional seating and the potential for greater revenues.

During construction we were responsible for landlord-tenant discussions, construction observation, and coordinating owner furnished contractors. Acuform's services included existing conditions survey, schematic design alternatives, design development, construction documents, equipment coordination, engineering, and permitting.
